### Artist's Statement



"Title"

I have been creating artworks for numerous years in many different media. I started with oil paints at the age of 12. Under the tutelage of Patricia Frey, a bay area artist, I experimented with acrylics, oil pastels, soft pastels and watercolor. During college, I became enamored with using clay to describe the human form. I also dabbled with several printmaking techniques. After all this experimentation, I've prefer using charcoal or a Tombow pen and water for working with live models and water soluble colored pencils for plein air sketches. Most of my current work translates these life drawn images and plein air landscapes to a computer where I use the program *Painter* as an artist's tool to produce final, one-of-a-kind painting

Over the past several years, ravens have been taking over the west coast, and nesting by my home. They are an iconic cultural symbol and very intelligent bird, however, they strike me as a bit ominous. I have created paintings with a substructure/texture based on decaying elements in our society: peeling paint, rotting wood, rusting metal, and then I add my raven images into the mix. Wanting to impart some hope and lightness into my paintings, I add in lyrical lines and light.

My digital artwork is created using the program "Painter" by Corel. All my pieces are originals. Each creation is a one-of-a-kind archival print. Selected images are printed on 100% acid-free rag paper, Epson 'Photo Quality Glossy Film' or canvas using archival inks and finished in an archival tradition. Treat your piece as you would a fine watercolor painting: avoid exposure to direct sunlight and high moisture environments.

In the past years, I've displayed my artwork in San Francisco bay area group shows, restaurants/galleries and universities. Current work has been displayed at the Santa Cruz Art League, the Santa Cruz Mountains Art Center, Works Gallery, San Jose, Image Snap, Museum of Art and History, Santa Cruz, Pajaro Valley Art Center and various on-line galleries.
